Why citizen bloggers

Our objective in the ARTS project is not to tell communities how to be more sustainable. Instead, we would like to understand the ongoing process of transition towards sustainability and work together with the community to accelerate it. We would like to recruit one citizen blogger per city to do the following:

- report on the most interesting transition initiatives in the city to the local and international audience
- follow project activities in this city, in cooperation with a local academic partner
- participate in project meetings on the European level and exchange experience with the project consortium, as well as with fellow citizen bloggers
